A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDING AGREEMENT WITH CENTURY TRANSPORTATION TO PROCEED WITH A ONE (1) YEAR ON DEMAND PILOT PROGRAM

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, which provides in part that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority;

AND WHEREAS Council expressed an interest in modifying/improving the municipal transit system to provide better value and service;


AND WHEREAS The Provincial and Federal Government have provided COVID19 relief funding under the Safe Restart Agreement which includes specific funding for municipal transit systems;

AND WHEREAS as part of the Phase 2 funding requirements, municipalities with low performing services are being encouraged to consider whether they may be better serviced by micro transit;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg enacts as follows:

1. THAT Council authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute an amending agreement with Century Transportation to proceed with a one (1) year on demand transit pilot program at a cost of \$27,300 plus HST;
2. THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect on the day of passing.
