

How to... DYE PASTA FOR CRAFTS

Supplies Needed:

- Pasta in different shapes and sizes
- Rubbing alcohol (1/4 cup for every 2 cups of pasta)
- Food colour
- Ziploc bags
- Parchment paper

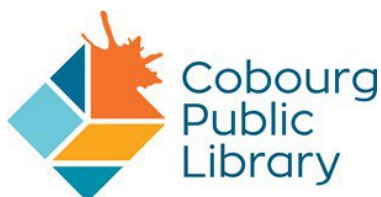
1. Take your ziploc bag (make sure it seals well). Add 1/4 cup rubbing alcohol and about 10 drops of food colour, use more or less food colour depending on how bright and vibrant you want the final colour to be. Swish in bag to mix.

2. Add 2 cups of pasta to the bag and seal it closed. Move the pasta around in the bag until it is evenly coated.

3. Lay the bag flat and leave to sit. Flip the bag every 15 minutes or so for an even coverage. The longer you let sit, the more vibrant the colour will be.

4. When you have your desired colour (half an hour to an hour), drain any excess alcohol and pour pasta onto parchment paper in a single layer to dry.

5. Once completely dry store in an airtight container or baggie.
