STEAM Experiments Try This At Home

START SEEDS IN EGGSHELLS

You will need:

- eggshells
- a spoonful soil per eggshell
- an egg carton
- seeds
- water

• Crack the eggs a bit more carefully than usually, trying to leave the lower two-thirds of the eggshell to one half intact. Wash them gently but thoroughly.

• Make a tiny drainage hole at the bottom using a pin and place the eggshell into egg carton.

- Fill ³⁄₄ full damp soil.
- · Plant your seeds.
- Place them somewhere else with lots of daylight.
- Spray with water every now and then to prevent drying out. Try not to over water.

• Eggshells provide the seeds with a safe home to sprout in and not only are the eggshells biodegradable – they will provide nutrients to your plants, too.
