Cobourg Establishes Urban Forest Management Plan to Provide Proactive Care of Town Trees over Next 20 Years

Community engagement strategy planned to gain insight and information from citizens

(Cobourg, ON) April 13, 2017 – The Town of Cobourg Recreation and Culture Division is initiating a project to establish an Urban Forest Management Plan to guide proactive care of Town trees over the next 20 years. The Urban Forest Management Plan (UFMP) will include a detailed community engagement process beginning with a public information and consultation session on April 26, 2017.

The goal of the UFMP is to ensure a healthy and sustainable urban forest that contributes to the economic, environmental and social vitality of the Town. The UFMP will establish guidelines and direction for care, planting, replacement and overall management of Town trees over the next 20 years. Cobourg Municipal Council is requesting that members of the public become involved in the project to provide input and information on the current and future desired state of Cobourg's urban forest. Background information will be provided to members of the public regarding the Town's current operations and guidelines. Members of the public can provide input regarding more opportunities for tree planting, areas in which more canopy cover is needed and the preservation of Cobourg's mature trees.

"The establishment of an Urban Forest Management Plan will allow the Town to move from reactive to proactive urban forest management," said Brian Darling, Coordinator of Parks and Recreation Services. "The plan will work in concert with the Parks Master Plan and will further Council's strategic plan objective of managing sustainable growth and development."

Plan content will include characterization of the current state of the Town's urban forest, analysis of current forestry management operations, identification of strategies to improve urban forest health and sustainability and recommended management changes and future needs. The Plan's main focus will be on the management of trees on public (Town) lands, however, consideration will be given to identifying strategies that will help maintain and increase the Town's urban forest on private lands.

The following are preliminary dates and times for Community Engagement tactics for the Urban Forest Management Plan. Please note some dates may be subject to change.
