

Pinecone Flowers

Supplies Needed:

- pinecones (various sizes)
- twigs
- hot glue gun and glue sticks
- board or canvas
- paint (optional)
- saw or seccateurs (optional)

Step One:

Remove the pinecone scales from the pinecone by wiggling and twisting. These will be the petals of your flowers.



Step Two:

Place a dot of hot glue along the side edge of the "petal" to attach them together. Continue in a circle until you have a flower shape. Between 5 and 8 petals per flower.



Step Three:

Use different parts of the pinecone to make flowers. The bottom of the pinecone makes a nice dahlia shape.



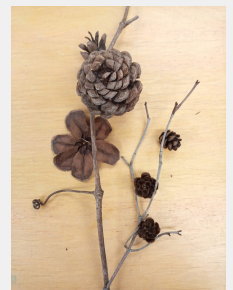
Step Four:

The top part of the pinecone makes a nice lily shape. You may need a saw or seccateurs to cut through the pinecone depending on the size of the pinecone



Step Five:

Use twigs for the stems of your flowers. Small pinecones make tiny roses. Arrange how you like.



Step Six:

Attach to something flat like a board, canvas or piece of cardboard. Paint your flowers or leave as is and you're done!
