Our Opening Ceremony will also showcase two powerfully moving exhibits: The Great War Exhibition: Art, Photography & Artifacts & Lest We Forget: Paintings by Charles Pachter Commemorating the First World War.

The Great War Exhibition: Art, Photography & Artifacts will present the following:

-<u>The Great War in Colour:</u> Archival photographs of Canadians in WWI that have been carefully restored and colourized under the sponsorship of the Vimy Foundation.

<u>Canada's Hundred Days</u>: Remarkable panoramic photographs by William Rider-Rider document the advance to victory of the Canadian troops in 1918.
<u>The Battle of Hill 70</u>: A museum display tells the story of this epic 1917 battle and the new monument erected to commemorate it.

- <u>Trench Art • Trench Life</u>: Features objects created by WWI soldiers from the collection of Garnet Barber along with artifacts from the Royal Canadian Military Institute and family archives.

- <u>Short Film:</u> Return to Vimy.

Lest We Forget: Paintings by Charles Pachter Commemorating the First World War will be hosted by the Art Gallery of Northumberland and show Pachter's outstanding series of contemporary Canadian paintings on WWI themes.
