WHEREAS at the Committee of the Whole meeting on February 21, 2023, Council considered a Memo from Planner I - Heritage, regarding the Affordable & Rental Housing Community Improvement Plan (CIP) Intake 2022 - Results and Recommendations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council award funding under the 2022 Affordable and Rental Housing CIP in the amount of \$40,431 under the Building Fees Program, \$6,995 under the Planning Fees Program, a \$10,000 grant under the Sustainable Design Program, and a \$10,000 grant under the Universal Design Program, totaling a \$67,427 grant to Trinity Housing of Cobourg Phase 2 Inc; and

FURTHER THAT Council award funding under the 2022 Affordable and Rental Housing CIP in the amount of \$10,000 each to Muhammad Kundan, Melanie Harness, Ivan Elder, and Denise Liboiron under the Second Unit Planning and Building Fee Reduction Program and the Second Unit Renovation and Construction Grant, and award funding to a maximum amount of \$1,200 being the actual amount of the Building Permit Fee to Melanie Powley under the Second Unit Planning and Building Fee Reduction Program; and

FURTHER THAT Council pass a By-law authorizing the Mayor and Municipal Clerk to execute the necessary funding agreements between the Town of Cobourg and the six (6) recipients of the 2022 Affordable and Rental Housing CIP Funding; and
