

Handprint Holiday Art: Santa Claus

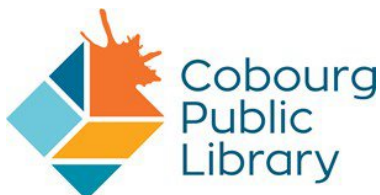


Supplies Needed: cream construction paper, red paint, 2 cotton balls, 1 red and 1 white pom pom, 2 googly eyes, glue, scissors, a paintbrush and a pencil

Steps:

1. Gather materials needed.
2. Select the cream construction paper and begin by tracing your handprint onto the paper with the pencil. Using the scissors, cut out your handprint.
3. Turn the handprint upside down. Take the red paint for Santa's hat. Add a small area of red paint to top half of your palm and then extend the red paint down the thumb of your handprint to create the rest of Santa's hat. Let dry.
4. Take one cotton ball and stretch it out to become the brim of Santa's hat. Glue it into place. Then glue 1 white pom pom to the end of Santa's hat.
5. Take the second cotton ball and stretch it out to make Santa's beard. Glue it onto the bottom of Santa's face.
6. Take the 2 googly eyes and glue them onto Santa's face.
7. Add the final touch by gluing the red pom pom over Santa's beard for Santa's nose.
8. Let dry and display!
