

Victoria Day Fireworks Craft

Make some colourful fireworks to celebrate the Victoria Day holiday.

Supplies Needed: black paper, white glue, pencil, water-based paint, table salt, paintbrush, tray and small bowl.

Steps

1. Gather the supplies. Place the piece of black paper in the tray. This will help to make the clean up easier.

2. Using a pencil, draw the lines of your fireworks. Take the white glue and add glue along your pencil marks. Continue until all of your fireworks are outlined with white glue.



3. Next sprinkle some table salt onto your paper and move the tray around to spread it over your fireworks. Add more salt as needed.

4. Lift up your paper to leave the excess salt on the tray.

5. Now you are ready to add colour to your fireworks. Add water to your bowl. Dip your paintbrush into the water and then add paint onto your brush. It is important to gently touch your brush to the salt/glue fireworks only. This will allow the salt to absorb the colour without wiping the mixture away.

6. Let dry, display and enjoy!
