Dear Boat Owner,



Although it does not seem like it now, the boating season will soon come to an end. As the end draws near, we must begin preparing for Lift Out and Storage. As in the past, lift out will be a collaborative effort between the Cobourg Yacht Club and the Marina. CYC will be providing the lifting services for all boats that lift-out with the crane. The marina will continue to provide transportation for the cradles and boats moving from the East Pier to the storage compound. The cost for the lifting service will be a flat fee based on boat length. All fees, as well as any outstanding balance on your account, must be paid in advance of services being rendered. This policy will be strictly adhered to. Please see the table below for the list of fees. The lift-out fee must be paid prior to Tuesday, September 19, 2017, in order for your boat to be scheduled for lift out. Again this year, current proof of insurance will be required prior to lift out, or being placed in the boat storage compound.

To assist us in making lift-out as efficient as possible, please complete the Lift-out Information Sheet below. **All documentation and payment should be returned to the marina office**. All documentation and payments must be received **no later** than September 19, 2017. Please note: if your boat is to be moved to an off-site location, it is your responsibility to have it moved from the east pier by no later than the Wednesday following Lift-out.

There will be two lift-out dates again this year: **Sept. 30** and **Oct. 21**. Any lift-out request received after Sept. 19 may be assigned to the Oct. 21 lift-out based on scheduling demands. For users of the mobile mast crane, this operation will begin on the Friday before each lift, Sept. 29 and Oct. 20, at 2:00 pm to de-step the masts. The cost for mast de-stepping services is \$90 per mast payable in cash on the day to Lakeshore Crane Service.

Please: Ensure your cradle or trailer is properly identified, with your name, boat name, bow and stern painted on the cradle. If the cradle is not properly identified, we cannot guarantee that it will be moved to the pier.

On the day of lift-out, have 30 foot bow and stern lines attached and ensure your motor is in good working order to avoid delay. Following lift out hydro and water to the docks, as well as the compound may be disconnected, without notice, any time after Oct. 22.

ALL BOATS MUST BE OUT OF THE MARINA SLIPS NO LATER THAN OCT. 23, 2017 to facilitate winterizing of the marina.
