**Victoria Park Campground Season Extended until October 23<sup>rd</sup>**

**Cobourg, ON (September 22, 2017)** – To meet increased demand for late-season camping, The Town of Cobourg will be extending the Victoria Park Campground season until Monday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017.

“We’ve had another busy summer and are seeing warmer temperatures well into the fall season,” said Paul Gauthier, Waterfront Services Manager for The Town of Cobourg. “With temperatures this comfortable it makes sense to extend the season for the further enjoyment of our campers.”

The campground will remain open for two weeks beyond the normal Thanksgiving Day closure date this year.
