For residential taxpayers in Cobourg, this year's tax rate of .0084246 represents a 1.3% increase over the 2012 tax rate.

The impact of this increase coupled with an average .2% assessment increase is set out below. There is also a comparison of your 2012 and 2013 tax bills on Schedule 2 of your bill.


Where do my Municipal Tax dollars go?

The Municipal portion of the median \$3,533.00 tax bill is \$1,955.00 or 55.4% of the bill. This represents a monthly charge of \$162.89.

Bring old paint, aerosols, diabetic insulin needles, pesticides, batteries, oil, fluorescent tubes and more to one of our four Household Hazardous Waste Depots in Northumberland County. The Cobourg Depot will be open from 8:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. on the following dates:

May 1, 2 and 4
June 5 and 8
July 3 and 6
August 7 and 10
September 4 and 7
October 2 and 5

Please no empty paint cans or containers.
