
#### For residential taxpayers in Cobourg, this year's tax rate of .0084656 represents a .5% increase over the 2013 tax rate.

#### **Illegal Dumping**

In all cases, the more information you have, the better chance of us catching the culprit! A license plate number and description of the person and vehicle helps tremendously. A reminder to never open bagged garbage in search of evidence - leave this for our by-law officers.

#### Household Hazardous Waste

Bring old paint, aerosols, diabetic insulin needles, pesticides, batteries, oil, fluorescent tubes and more to one of our four Household Hazardous Waste Depots in Northumberland County. The Cobourg Depot will be open from 8:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. on the following dates:

April 2, 3 and 5 May 7, 8 and 10 June 4 and 7 July 2 and 5 August 6 and 9 September 3 and 6 October 1 and 4

Please no empty paint cans or containers. Take Advantage of the **Electronics Drop-Off** at the Depots as well - TVs, computers, monitors, cell phones, VCRs and more can be brought free of charge when the Depot is open.
