Waterfront User Needs Assessment and Detailed Design Interactive pre-charrette workshops – April 10th & 11th

The Town of Cobourg is embarking on a project to develop and implement a comprehensive Waterfront User Needs Assessment and Detailed Design. The Town is committed to community engagement and a detailed Community Engagement Strategy for this project was approved by Council on March 13, 2017.

In addition to four Interactive Public Open Houses and an interactive Community Design Charrette consultants from *thinc design* will be hosting interactive pre-charrette workshops with representatives of organized community groups that have significant interest in the waterfront's access and development.
