Cobourg Public Library Board

The Cobourg Municipal Council is seeking seven (7) Community Representatives for its Public Library Board. Applicants must be eligible members pursuant to Section 10(1) of the Public Libraries Act.

Cobourg Police Services Board

Applicants are expected to have an understanding of the role of a Police Services Board under the Police Services Act, and have previous volunteer experience in community organizations.

Persons ineligible to apply include judges, justices of the peace, police officers and individuals who practice criminal law as a defence counsel.

All Committee and Board Appointments are for the term of Council (2018 – 2022), unless otherwise legislated. Qualified candidates must have the ability to complete a favorable Criminal Record Check.
