Development News in Cobourg Corner of Burnham Street and Depalma Drive



Town of Cobourg Announces Launch of Cobourg Rides On-Demand Transit System

On April 19, 2021, the Town of Cobourg will be soft launching "Cobourg Rides", a town-wide, demand-based, public transit service available to all residents and visitors on a trial basis.

The benefits of on-demand transit include:

- Easy online booking through the 'Pick-Up On-Demand' App.
- Reliable on-demand transportation.
- Real-time vehicle tracking.
- Cashless payment system.

The **Cobourg Rides** On-Demand Transit Trial will be launched in two distinct phases. During the first phase (April 19th to June 13th) Conventional Transit will continue to operate Monday to Friday from 6:15 a.m. to 5 p.m. The second phase will begin on June 14th with all services (WHEELS and Conventional Transit) switching to the on-demand service.
