Cobourg Receives Funding from the Inclusive Communities Grants Program

The Town of Cobourg has received \$60,000 to enhance accessibility within the downtown core ensuring all residents are able to safely access areas of business, parks and Victoria Hall.

This initiative is funded entirely by the Inclusive Communities Grant Program awarded by the Ministry of Seniors and Accessibility. The Town of Cobourg completed the application in December 2020 and received notice of the success of the application in March 2021.

Emergency Control Group Reviews the Lastest Provincial Public Health Guidelines

The Town of Cobourg has reviewed the new regulations and tightened restrictions from the Stay-At-Home Order, and updated the changes to municipal services and programs.

As of April 19, 2021:

- Outdoor gatherings must be with members of vour household only. Those who live alone may join one household.
- are **open** if both the children and their parents can maintain a physical distance of at least two metres from others.
- parks are **open** for exercise purposes only.
- All Town parks or recreational areas including the Victoria Park Beach remain open for the purposes of permitting persons to walk recreational area.
- 🗪 Sports facilities, multi-use fields, basketball courts, baseball diamonds, tennis and pickleball courts, soccer fields, and the skateboard park are closed.
- X All non-essential construction is closed.
