



\$2 Cash Fare Resumes on Conventional Transit Effective January 26

The \$2 cash fare for Conventional Transit has resumed effective Tuesday, January 26, 2021. All previously purchased transit tickets will be honoured and passes purchased in February or March 2020 can be utilized until the end of February 2021.

As per the Provincial 'Stay-at-Home Order', public transit should only be used for essential purposes. Masks are mandatory while using the transit shelters and riding the bus.
