### Ontario Expands Vaccination Eligibility and Accelerates Timeline

As of Tuesday, May 11, 2021, residents with at-risk health conditions such as dementia, diabetes and sickle cell disease, as well as Group Two of people who cannot work from home including grocery store, restaurant and transportation workers can book an vaccination appointment.

For the HKPRDHU region, the following is an anticipated age-based schedule for vaccines:

- **55+ years:** as of April 30, 2021.
- **50+ years:** as of May 6, 2021.
- **40+ years:** as of May 13, 2021.
- **30+ years:** the week of May 17, 2021.
- **18+ years:** the week of May 24, 2021.

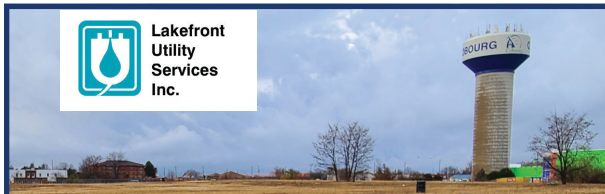
