Ontario Expands Vaccination Eligibility and Accelerates Timeline

Due to a stable and reliable increase in vaccine supply, the province and its partners now have the ability to expand COVID-19 vaccine booking eligibility over the next month and further accelerate timelines to get more shots into arms.

For the HKPRDHU region, the following is an anticipated schedule for vaccine roll-out in May:

- **55+ years:** as of April 30, 2021.
- **50+ years:** as of May 6, 2021.
- **40+ years:** the week of May 10, 2021.
- **30+ years:** the week of May 17, 2021.
- **18+ years:** the week of May 24, 2021.
