



CITIZENS INVITED TO APPLY TO FILL A POSITION ON THE NEWLY ESTABLISHED COUNCIL REMUNERATION AD HOC COMMITTEE

The Cobourg Municipal Council welcomes applications from citizens interested in becoming involved and actively participate in this community by serving as a volunteer on the **Council Remuneration Ad Hoc Committee**. Cobourg Council are seeking applications to fill one (1) Citizen Position on the Council Remuneration Ad Hoc Committee.

On January 15th 2018, Council approved a resolution of striking a Council Remuneration Ad Hoc Committee with a mandate to review the current compensation package including benefits paid to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Members of Council.

The Committee will function as an Ad-hoc Committee of Council. The role of the Committee is to research, develop and present a report and recommendation of Council Remuneration for the term 2018 - 2021.

Areas to be addressed include:

1. An understanding of what is asked and expected when an individual is elected to Municipal Council;
2. Responsibility level of the office as elected representatives of the citizens of the Town of Cobourg based upon the position held being Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Councillor;
3. Remuneration compared to other similar Ontario Municipalities having a similar population and having a seven (7) member Council comprised of one (1) mayor, one (1) deputy mayor and five (5) Councillors wherever possible to reflect the current make-up of the Town of Cobourg Municipal Council.

The Committee's mandate will expire once Council has approved the rate of remuneration for the 2018 - 2021 Council Term.
