POLICE SERVICE BOARD - COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVE VACANCY

Cobourg Residents Invited to Apply to Fill a Vacancy on the Cobourg Police Services Board

The Cobourg Municipal Council welcomes applications from citizens interested in becoming involved in the community by serving as a volunteer for the Community Representative vacancy on its Police Services Board.

The Cobourg Police Services Board is comprised of:

- the Mayor Head of Council
- one (1) member of the council appointed by resolution of the Council;
- one (1) person appointed by resolution of the Council, and
- two (2) persons appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

The Ontario Police Services Act R.S.O. 1990, cP.15 provides the responsibilities of Police Services Boards respecting oversight, labour relations and quasi-judicial functions.

All committee and board appointments are for the term of Council (2014-2018) unless otherwise legislated. The term of this vacancy appointment will expire on November 30, 2018, which may be extended for a further term by Municipal Council. Applicants must be qualified as electors for the Town of Cobourg, have the ability to complete a favorable Criminal Record Check, have an understanding of the role of a Police Services Board under the *Police Services Act*, and have previous volunteer experience in community organizations including previous experience on boards or committees would be considered an asset. Remuneration is provided to Board Members based on Council resolution.

Persons who are ineligible to apply include a judge, a justice of the peace, a police officer and a person who practices criminal law as a defense counsel.
