As Research Assistant the individual will lead the initiative of collecting surveys and information from tourists and local residents participating in Cobourg's many attractions and events. Data will be used to assess the success of Town of Cobourg Marketing initiatives as well as gain insight into the economic benefit of tourism and special events.

As part of the Experience Ambassador program, you are required to have a clear understanding of the experiences and services Cobourg offers (e.g attractions, community events, restaurants, hotels, shops, parking etc.).

Responsibilities:

- Have a clear understanding of the experiences and services Cobourg offers
- Provide correct information to customers (residents and visitors)
- Assess Town of Cobourg survey questions for the Cobourg Marina, Victoria Park
 Campground and Experience Cobourg (Tourism) and make recommendations and or
 improvements to best achieve our goals
- Assist and/or lead recruitment of participants in tourism data collection and ensure high levels of research data quantity and quality
- Working with the Manager of Marketing and events and Experience Ambassador colleagues, suggest incentives that could be promoted on social media channels
- Work with the DBIA and downtown merchants to collect data and information on impact of tourism, special events and filming
- Working with the Manager of Marketing and Events, conduct quarterly assessments of data. Make updates to surveys and or strategies as required
- Provide weekly updates on the number of visitors and frequently asked questions by guests
- Assist in developing an end of season report on the economic benefit of the 2020 tourism season
- Support the Experience Ambassadors in all duties as needed

Required Skills and Qualifications:

- Enrolled in a Post-Secondary program with a focus on Economics, Statistics, Marketing, Business or Tourism/Hospitality
- Must be returning to full time studies in fall of 2020
- Must have or be willing to obtain prior to hire First Aid/CPR Certification
