BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 021-2014 BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE LICENSING AND REGISTRATION OF DOGS; FOR THE REGULATION OF DOGS AND FOR PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE TOWN OF COBOURG.

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the *Municipal Act*, 2001, Section 11 as amended, municipalities have the authority to pass by-laws with respect to animals; and

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg deems it advisable to pass a by-law for the licencing, registration and for the regulation of dogs within the Town of Cobourg limits;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg authorized an amendment to By-law No. 021-2014 at a Committee of the Whole meeting held on August 11, 2014, and deems it advisable to amend Schedule "A" being a sample 'Order to Restrain' to include the provisions contained in Section 5 (g) and (h) of the By-law for consistency;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of The Corporation of Cobourg hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Schedule "A" of By-law 021-2014 being a By-law for the Licensing and Registration of Dogs; for the Regulation of Dogs and for Prohibiting the Running at Large of Animals regarding the 'Order to Restrain' be amended and replaced.
- 2. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing hereof.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed in Open Council this 11<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2014.
