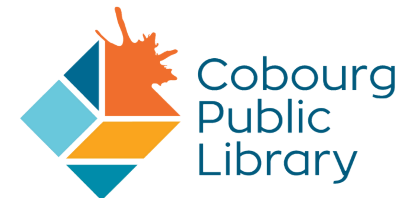

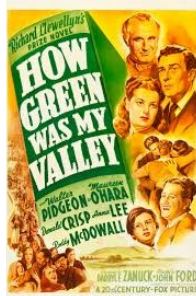
## AT THE LIBRARY

1979 - 123 Mins

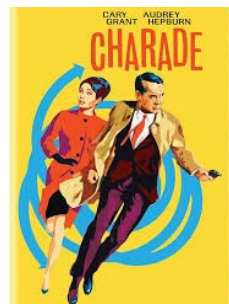

1940 - 12 Mins

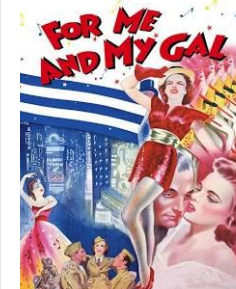
