**A BY-LAW TO REPEAL VARIOUS TOWN OF COBOURG BY-LAWS PASSED AND ENACTED IN 1973 NOW COVERED BY PROVINCIAL LEGISLATION AND ARE NOT UNDER MUNICIPAL JURISDICTION RECOMMENDED FOR REPEAL, AND BY-LAWS THAT ARE NO LONGER RELEVANT/REQUIRED.**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 25 as amended, confers broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 10 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, as amended, provides that the council of a local municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public; and

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 10 (2) of the *Municipal Act* S.O. 2001, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the sphere of jurisdiction of services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide; and

**AND WHEREAS** Council established a By-law Review Protocol based on the Town of Cobourg Strategic Plan 2011-2014 objective #4 for continuously improving municipal policies and procedures. As part of the protocol, Council are to review and act on Town by-laws that are five years or older including those that are categorized as:

- i) by-laws now covered by Provincial legislation and not under municipal jurisdiction which are recommended for repeal; and
- ii) by-laws that are no longer relevant/required - recommended for repeal;

**AND WHEREAS** at the Committee of the Whole meeting of February 25, 2013 Council authorized preparation of a by-law to repeal various By-laws passed in 1973 deemed as being no longer relevant and should be repealed;

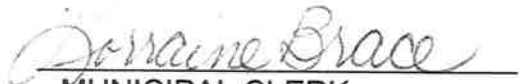
**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg enacts as follows:

1. THAT By-law No. 26-73 being a By-law to require all residents of Cobourg owning and using bicycles to obtain licenses therefore and to fix an annual fee for such licences and By-law No. 24-77 being a By-law to amend (and) By-law 1870 requiring a bi-annual bicycle licence be hereby repealed.

2. THAT By-law No. 51-73 being a By-law to prohibit loitering in a public place, street, sidewalk or highway be hereby repealed.
3. THAT By-law No. 68-73 being a By-law to define the duties of the Clerk-Administrator be hereby repealed.
4. THAT By-law No. 76-73 being a By-law to license, regulate and govern electrical contractors be hereby repealed.
5. THAT By-law No. 50-74 being a By-law to amend By-law 76-73 to establish a fee to license, regulate and govern electrical contractors be hereby repealed.
6. THAT By-law No. 77-73 being a By-law to licence, regulate and govern plumbing contractors be hereby repealed.
7. THAT By-law No. 70-81 being a By-law to amend By-law No. 77-73 to establish a fee to licence, regulate and govern plumbing contractors be hereby repealed.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed in Open Council this 4th day of March, 2013.
