Rates



Downtown Parking

Downtown parking rates apply **year-round, from January 1 to December 31.**

- First three (3) hours FREE
- \$2.50/hr after 3 hours



Waterfront Parking

Waterfront parking rates are **seasonal**, with **High** and **Low Season** rates.

Low Season (September 15 to May 14)

- First three (3) hours FREE
- \$2.50/hr after 3 hours | \$20/day

High Season (May 15 to September 14)

- \$5/hr | \$40/day
- There is NO free parking in Waterfront Lots and on-street during High Season

Payment

Payment for parking can be made at the Pay and Display machines, parking meters or through the **HONK Mobile** app.



Permits

The following permits provide parking year-round at *all municipal lots and on-street*:



Cobourg Resident Permit

Year-Round (January 1 to December 31)

- \$10/month | \$120/ for 1-year



Northumberland County Resident Permit

Year-Round (January 1 to December 31)

- \$40/month | \$480 for 1-year

The following permits provide parking at *Waterfront Lots and on-street*.



Visitor Waterfront Permit (Low Season)

September 15 to May 14 | \$35/month



Visitor Waterfront Permit (High Season)

May 15 to September 14

- \$80/month | \$320 for the season



Overnight Permit

Overnight Daily Permit \$10/night

Overnight Monthly Permit \$100/month

For use in *all Municipal Lots*.



DBIA Employee Permit

\$20/month | \$240 for 1-year

For use in *all Downtown Lots. Excludes Waterfront.*

FAQs

How do I pay for additional parking after first three hours free?

Additional parking can be purchased at Pay and Display Machines, on-street meters or via HONK Mobile App.

Where can I purchase a Parking Permit?

Online: parking.cobourg.ca

In-Person: Victoria Hall (55 King St West) and MLELS Office (201 Second Street), Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Does my Permit include overnight parking?

The Resident Permit includes overnight parking in Municipal Lots and downtown on-street. The Northumberland County Resident Permit include overnight parking in Municipal Lots only. Visitor Permits do not include overnight parking.

How many vehicles can I add to my Permit?

Two vehicles can be registered on one Parking Permit and both vehicles can utilize the permit at the same time.

When is parking enforced?

Parking is enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Overnight parking is from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Who qualifies for free accessible parking?



Accessible parking in Cobourg is free for Cobourg Residents who have registered for an annual Cobourg

Resident Accessible Permit. Visitors (non-residents) are required to pay applicable parking rates. Accessible on-street parking spaces have a 3-hour time limit.
